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1. Definition,

Unless the subject or context requires otherwise, in this policy-

- "Scholarship" means the Scholarship Guidelines of Samriddhi College.
- "Selection Committee" means the Scholarship Selection Committee of Samriddhi College.
- "Main Subject" means the subject prescribed in a public notice published while calling for an application for scholarship.

2. Preface

As part of its social responsibility, Samriddhi College shall give equal opportunity to deserving candidates from underprivileged families. Scholarships help students achieve their academic goals and thereby contribute to improving the nation's human resources. Scholarships are given to qualifying students based on particular criteria, government policy, and the institution's social duties.

3. Purpose

The primary goal of the Samriddhi College Scholarship is to provide financial help to economically disadvantaged and academically qualified students from Nepal's seven Provinces.

4. Scholarship Criteria

The scholarship will be provided as per the criteria and norms set by the 'Guidelines for Scholarships'' by Samriddhi College and Tribhuvan University.

5. Social Responsibility Scholarship

Prayas Nepal and Samriddhi College have signed (MoU) with the intention of awarding Social responsibility scholarships to **two** students for assisting underprivileged students. These students come from low-income families and encounter financial challenges that keep them from pursuing higher education.

6. Eligibility

The students that are currently enrolled in Grade XI from 77 districts of Nepal are eligible to apply for a scholarship examination, which will be held online/Offline.

7. Application for Samriddhi Scholarship

Step1: Registration shall be done via online media.

Step2: Information shall be provided about registration.

Step3: Exam date and time will be provided via SMS.

Step4: The result shall be shortlisted and information shall be provided in the college website.

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8. Selection Procedure:

8.1 Selection Committee

- The Principal or the Board will constitute the Scholarship Selection Committee (SSC) with input from the nominated members.
- Two candidates will be presented to the committee for consideration. One of them will be the coordinator, and the others will be participating in the evaluation.
- The tenure of the selection committee cannot be more than two years.
- The committee members must reach an agreement on the scholarship recipient's selection based on the conditions and eligibility.

8.2 Procedure of Selection

- The Selection Committee will send a registered letter to the top-ranked qualifying applicants on the merit list, asking them if they are willing to accept the scholarship within 15 days of receiving it.
- Candidates who fail to respond to a request for their willingness to be considered for a scholarship within 30 days will be rejected, and the grant will be awarded to the next qualifying candidate on the merit list.
- The scholarship application will be designed, altered, or changed by the selection committee. The application's final design may be authorized by the Principal or the Board of Directors (BOD).

9. Documents submit to Selection Committee

- Application letter requesting Scholarship
- One-on-one interview with Principal
- Letter(s) of recommendation (Municipal or from Previous Institution)
- A character Certificates
- A letter of Acceptance (Entrance Test Result)
- Transcripts from high school or college.

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10. Equitable to all Students

The standards support ideal scholarship that is not subject to prejudice and is not bound by legal constraints.

11. Authorization of Decision

The principal authorizes all the decisions before they will come into implementation. If the Principal feels any biases in the selection, then the principal requests the selection committee/Board of Directors to rethink the selection partially or perform a case-specific review.

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
