Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) Between Samriddhi College and Prayas Nepal.

Agenda: Scholarship support to students from underprivileged background

Parties: This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made and entered into by Prayas Nepal, a non-profit organization based in Nepal, and Samriddhi College, a higher education institution located in Nepal.

Purpose: The purpose of this agreement is to provide scholarship support to two students annually who are direct beneficiaries of Prayas Nepal and are recommended by Prayas Nepal for higher study at Samriddhi College.

Prayas Nepal and Samriddhi College hereby agree to the following terms:

- 1. Scholarship: Scholarships will cover the full cost of tuition and fees for the duration of the students' studies at Samriddhi College, in the undergraduate programs other than Bsc CSIT.
- 2. Eligibility: To be eligible for this scholarship, students must be direct beneficiaries of Prayas Nepal and must meet all admission requirements for Samriddhi College.
- 3. Selection: Prayas Nepal will recommend two students for the scholarship annually. Samriddhi College will review the recommendations and may accept or reject them at its discretion. If a recommended student is not accepted, Prayas Nepal may recommend an alternate student.
- 4. **Duration:** This scholarship will be granted for the duration of the students' studies at Samriddhi College, subject to the student's satisfactory academic progress as determined by Samriddhi College.
- 5. Renewal: This agreement will be in effect for a period of two years, during which both the Samriddhi College and Prayas Nepal will review the impact of the collaboration, after which it may be renewed by mutual agreement of the parties. Before renewal, the college may assess its capacity to continue the support.
- 6. **Termination:** This Agreement may be terminated by either Party upon written notice if the other Party breaches any material term or condition of this Agreement. However, the college can't drop the continuing support to students already enrolled under this partnership spirit.





- 7. Confidentiality: samriddhi College shall maintain the privacy of the students, and shall not disclose or provide any data or information to a third party without the consent of the respective student and Prayas Nepal.
- 8. Governing Law: This mutual understanding will be executed upon mutual understanding and can be reviewed and updated when necessary. However, for any dispute, if arise, this Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Nepal Government
