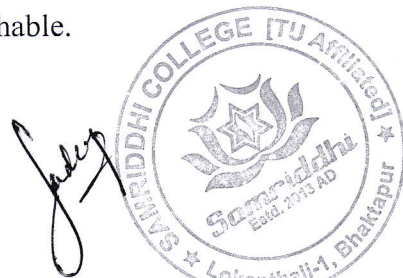
Students' Code of Conduct

Every college formulates rules and regulations that are to be strictly followed by the students. The following rules are specified with respect to the conduct of students and procedures for handling disciplinary offenses. This policy covers all college students whereas students are to conduct themselves in accordance with these principles.

They should show proper concern in their behavior for the reputation of the college and the student body, and for its effect on their fellow students, staff and their juniors. Misconduct is behavior which interferes with the proper functioning of the college and its activities with damage of college reputation that result to the warning, suspension, rustication or any other penalty as per the college rules.

Code of Conduct for the Students:

- Every student must be punctual with the proper dress code along with their identity card.
- Latecomers will not be entertained to enter into the classroom.
- Every student is expected to maintain cleanliness within the classrooms, laboratories and the college in general.
- Any act which obstructs teaching, research, administrative activity and other proceedings of the college is strictly prohibited.
- Every student should remain answerable to the college authority for his/her activity and conduct on the college premises.
- During leisure hours, students are advised to use the library as maximum as possible.
- Use of cellphones is strictly prohibited during class hour or in the college.
- Indulging ragging, anti-institutional, anti-national, antisocial, communal, immoral or political expressions and activities within the college are strongly prohibited and can be punishable.



- Without the permission of the Principal or Department Heads, students are not allowed to circulate any printed materials within the college.
- Attempted or actual theft and/or damage to property of the college, or property of a member of the college community, or other personal or public property, on or off college will be considered as a punishable act.
- Students should handle the college properties with care. Damage to the furniture or any other materials may lead to penalty or suspension from the college.
- Chewing paan, paan masala, gutka or any other tobacco products, smoking or consumption of any other intoxicating products is strictly prohibited and if found he/she will be punished according to college rules.
- Playing cards, spitting and loitering are strictly prohibited inside the college and shall invite severe punishment/disciplinary action.
- A student should maintain at least 75% attendance in the lectures of every subject and 100% overall performance. Otherwise, he or she will be debarred from the University Examination.
- Students are required to check the notice board and also the college website for important announcements.
